This e-book will cover things that invite demonic spirits and accompanying harassment into our lives. It will not deal with harassment itself. For readers wishing to know more about what demonic harassment is and the infinite number of forms it can take, this topic is covered in my e-book [Spirit Harassment from A to Z.](#)

Introduction by Stacie Spielman:

Victims of demonic harassment often ask the questions “Why me?” “What did I do to deserve this?” And “How can I put an end to it?”

Questions one and two are nothing more than dual aspects of the same question. The answer is there are at least twelve possibilities:

(1) The harassment victim has dabbled in some aspect of the occult.

(2) The harassment victim has moved into a house where spirits and spirit activity are already present.

Spirits in situations such as this have “squatter’s rights” until the new home owner or tenant takes steps to oust them.

(3) The harassment victim has either abused someone or been a victim of abuse. This includes sexual, physical, verbal, or mental abuse. Abusive situations are a virtual magnet for demonic spirits. In some cases, demonic spirits are at the root of the abuse in the first place. (Sexual abuse may take the form of forced intercourse, fondling, exposure, rape, forcible oral sex, or vaginal or anal insertion of sex toys or other objects.)

(4) The harassment victim or her spouse has dabbled in or is addicted to pornography – pornographic websites, porn films, etc. I’ve worked with many women who were victims of demonic harassment due to their husbands’ addiction to porn.

One lady was actually committed to a mental institution and diagnosed as schizophrenic as a result of spirits chattering in her head. These spirits had come to her as a result of her husband’s addiction to pornography.

(5) The harassment victim is into games such as Dungeons and Dragons, or violent or demonic video games.

(6) Spirits have been passed down through the person's ancestry. This can happen if an ancestor has dabbled in the occult or been a free Mason, a follower of an Eastern religion, a witch, a witch doctor or medicine man, a psychic a cult member, a member of the Ku Klux Klan, or a member of a spiritist religion or culture. In the case of blacks in America, spirits have in many cases been passed down having to do with ancestors having been slaves and/or victims of prejudice and violence, and/or as a result of ancestors having been involved with voodoo or black magic. Native Americans usually have spirits passed down to them by virtue of the fact that theirs is a spiritist culture.

(7) The harassment victim has purchased, found, or received as a gift an item with spirits attached. Examples of this are the teen-aged girl I worked with who had spirits that had come with a wedding necklace from India, the lady who had spirits that had come with a statue of Buddha, and the couple who had spirits in association with ivory jewelry they had purchased from Eskimos in Alaska.

(8) A parent or grandparent has dabbled in the occult, and now their children are suffering the consequences.

(9) The harassment victim is into heavy metal music.

(10) The harassment victim has a fascination with violent or occult things such as medieval torture or serial killers.

(11) The harassment victim has visited a site where occult activity has taken place.

(12) Someone has placed a curse, spell, or hex on the harassment victim.

Before getting into things that invite demonic spirits into our lives, I want to give you some basic information about the spirit realm, and demonic spirits in general.

For starters, spirits are not the ghosts of humans who have died. Spirits of the dead do not hang around on earth to haunt our houses and make our lives miserable. They do not hang around to complete unfinished business or vendettas. And they do not come back to visit their friends and loved ones.

In the Bible, the apostle Paul says that to be absent from the body is to be present with the Lord. And the book of Deuteronomy warns us not to associate with spiritists – people who associate or communicate with spirits. It's been my experience that when people do this, spirits transfer to them, and they in turn, join the ranks of demonic harassment victims.

Based on personal experience and the experiences of harassment victims I've worked with, I've discovered that spirits never work alone. They typically work in very large groups that are multiples of three. This is in keeping with the fact that Satan was once in Heaven

and understands the importance of three and multiples of three in God's realm: Jesus started His ministry at the age of 30. He ministered for three years and then was crucified. He hung on the cross for three hours before his death at six o'clock, then lay in the tomb for three days before his resurrection.

There are other examples, but I believe these, along with what I've already pointed out about demonic spirits, are sufficient to show the importance that both sides of the spirit realm place on the number three and multiples of it.

It is my belief that demonic spirits are the fallen angels that were kicked out of Heaven after siding with Satan when he rebelled. My reason for this belief is that there is no mention in the Bible of God's having created demons or spirits. The Bible does speak of God's having created people, animals, and angels. When speaking of these angels, the Bible sometimes uses the word "spirit." And when speaking of fallen angels, it calls them spirits or demons. Also, when I used to do spirit cast aways on behalf of harassment victims I worked with, a spirit once spoke to me through the person I was working with to say, "Yes, we are fallen angels."

If we accept the precept that demonic spirits are fallen angels, that would account for their awesome powers. I have personally witnessed a demonic spirit converting an ordinary Sprite into an alcoholic strawberry daiquiri. (See my e-book *Betrayed by Her Guardian Angel*, available through my website at staciespielman.com and through Amazon). While working with an harassment victim by phone, I

listened as this man tried to destroy a ceramic horse that had appeared in his wife's lap out of nowhere. Prior to this, his three-year-old daughter who was the victim of severe harassment had taken a Christmas ornament off the tree and broken it. Inside the ornament was a nail! The little girl had used the nail as a weapon to attack her older brother.

Ted asked if I thought he should smash the ceramic horse on the hearth to find out whether it too contained a nail or similar object. Considering that the nail in the ornament had made no sound, he reasoned that it might be the same with the ceramic horse.

I told him he needed to dispose of the horse, and left it to his discretion whether or not to first smash it. When Ted slammed the ceramic horse against the bricks all I heard was a thud. It didn't break. He struck the hearth again with the same result.

We were discussing this odd phenomenon by phone when Ted suddenly gasped. "You're not going to believe this," he said. "I'm not sure I believe it myself." He went on to say that the ceramic horse was no longer ceramic. It had been transformed to the texture of hard rubber. If he used all his strength, he could bend it. But the horse would not break. He tried hitting the rubber horse with a hammer. Finally he gave up. I advised him to put the horse in a bag so no one would see it and take it out of his trash, then carry it out to the garbage can.

That's an important point. When disposing of something that's of the occult – a Ouija board, Tarot

cards, energized crystals, etc. – make sure you either destroy them or put them into a bag or box so no one will be tempted to take them out of the trash

In this e-book, there will be many references to “the Occult.” For those of you who don’t know what this term means, Occult means *hidden* as in the source of the power for witchcraft, or as in spirits being invisible except when they choose to show themselves. Though there are other meanings of the word occult, it usually refers to supernatural practices and techniques.

Things that are of the occult invite demonic spirits and accompanying harassment into a person’s life.

For purposes of this e-book, any time I say the word “spirit” I’m referring to the demonic, regardless of whether I say “demonic” or not.

Given that before a person can break free of demonic spirits and the harassment that comes with them, he must identify all the “open doors” in his life, e.g. all unsevered links to the spirit realm and the occult., it stands to reason that he needs to know the specifics of what all comes under the umbrella of the 12 items I presented earlier in this book.

Things That Invite or Attract Demonic Spirits:

Caution: Do not attempt to do spirit cast outs or cast aways on your own as you read through this book. This should be done only after going through the necessary steps to cut all ties and “close all doors” to the occult and the spirit

realm. And it should not be done without the presence of a Christian helper who has no links of his own to the occult. Complete instructions are included in my e-book “What Demonic Spirits Don’t Want You to Know; What Traditional Deliverance Ministries Don’t Tell You.”

This said, the most common element that opens the door and invites demonic harassment is for a person to dabble in any aspect of the occult, no matter how innocent this aspect may seem.

The problem is that most people don’t recognize “normal” things that many of us do or own as being of the occult: things such as psychic readings, dream catchers, wearing a crucifix or other amulet for protection, or the levitation game Lighter Than Air.

Abuse (sexual, physical, mental, emotional, or severe verbal):

Abusive situations of any kind invite demonic spirits and demonic harassment. Demonic spirits don’t care that the abuse victim is innocent and undeserving of the abuse. Often the abuser is himself a victim of demonic harassment, and the harassing spirits will urge him to hurt or kill his victim.

Adulterous Relationships:

By “adulterous” I’m referring to having sex or a romantic relationship (even phone sex) with a person who’s married to someone else; or as a married person, having sex or a romantic relationship with someone other than your spouse.

Non-Medical Abortion:

I worked with a woman we'll call Cathy, who had gotten pregnant as a result of an affair, and had an abortion at her boyfriend's insistence to get rid of the baby, even though there was no medical reason to do so. The woman had spirits in her life as a result, and so did her boyfriend.

I myself had an abortion back in the 1980's. (See my e-book *Nowhere to Turn*, available through my website at staciespielman.com and through Amazon). After working with Cathy years later, I addressed whether I had spirits in my life from my own abortion. There was a huge manifestation, even though the abortion had been performed more than twenty years ago.

I have never worked with a woman who's had an abortion for medical reasons, so I can't address that.

Antiques:

Any time you acquire something that's very old and don't know who all has owned it or what they've been involved with, it's a good idea to cast away any spirits that might have come with it. (Don't try this until you've read the instructions in my e-book *What Demonic Spirits Don't Want You to Know; What Traditional Deliverance Ministries Don't Tell You* – available in pdf format on my website at staciespielman.com, and through Amazon and Smashwords in formats for various E-Book Readers.

I worked with a woman who had an antique oil lamp that had come from the ancestry of a person she'd never met. As it turned out, there were spirits

attached to the base, the wick, the glass globe, the oil, and the knob for turning the wick up and down.

By “attached,” I don’t mean spirits were literally attached in a physical way. The best way I can think of to describe it is to say that they were using various parts of the lamp as a home base.

When these spirits were cast away through God in Jesus’ name, the woman saw them leave in the form of fog and a cloud of glitter. (Note: spirits can choose whether or not to *appear* to the person.)

African and Other Spiritist Tribal Charms:

Charms, amulets, or talismans from any spiritist culture bring with them demonic spirits.

Ancestral Spirits:

The Bible says that sins of the father will be visited upon the son even unto the third and fourth generations. I have found this to be true in working with harassment victims. Many have had spirits in their lives dating back several generations: spirits of racism, spirits of violence, spirits of rage, spirits of abuse, spirits of prejudice and intolerance, and/or spirits of rage.

One black woman that I worked with had spirits dating back to when her ancestors were slaves.

Angel Board:

Angel Board is nothing but a fancy name for Ouija Board. It’s someone’s ignorant attempt to make certain that only “spirits of light” can speak through it. But the fact is that our words don’t control demonic

spirits. Our saying “This board is only for angels” is not going to stop demons from using it. Based on what I’ve learned from the Bible, and what demonic spirits have told me through the mouths of harassment victims as I cast them out through God in Jesus’ name, it is my belief that demonic spirits are themselves angels. The difference between them and other angels is that they rebelled against God and were kicked out of Heaven down to the earth.

Asking for spirit guides:

Asking for spirit guides is asking for trouble. God does not provide spirit guides. Demonic forces do.

The Bible makes no mention of spirit guides. We learn of them from psychics such as Sylvia Browne and others who are involved with the paranormal and various other aspects of the occult.

My own former spirit guides who swore they were of God turned out to be demons. So have the spirit guides of each and every harassment victim I’ve worked with.

It stands to reason that if everyone else’s spirit guides are demons Sylvia Browne’s are too. Her main guide Francine says there is no Satan, and that there are no evil spirits either.

Astrological chart:

Astronomy is a legitimate science. Astrology is of the occult. The Bible refers to astrologers as “star gazers.”

Although there appears there may be some validity in astrological signs and characteristics, gaining information this way is a form of divination. Any form of divination opens the doors to demonic harassment.

Automatic Drawing, Painting, Typing, and Writing:

There is no such thing as truly automatic drawing, painting, typing, or writing. In the case of each of these it's a spirit taking over the pencil, paintbrush, or fingers on the keyboard and doing the work.

Attempting to do automatic writing – that is, sitting with a pen or pencil poised over a paper and waiting for something to happen – invites demonic spirits to do the writing for you.

I did Automatic Writing in college. I actually wrote a college paper that way and made a note on the bottom telling how the paper had been written. My professor was so impressed that he told a colleague. His colleague called me into his office to ask if I could teach him my technique. The spirit that guided my pen to write that paper had made quite a hit.

The fact that psychologists often use automatic writing in an effort to contact their patients' subconscious minds means nothing. Psychologists aren't trained to think in terms of the realm of demonic spirits.

Belief in Magical Creatures such as Fairies, Sprites, Pixies, Nymphs, or Leprechauns:

Belief in these magical creatures has its roots in England, Ireland, and other Celtic countries. Many people in these countries have reported actually seeing the little creatures.

This is not evidence that these winged and miniature beings actually exist. Demonic spirits are at the root of this belief. They have appeared in this form to make people believe.

When I had my deliverance ministry working with victims of demonic harassment, there were those who'd been visited by fairies and other magical creatures. In every case, when I addressed these magical entities, they manifested as demonic spirits. Spirits can appear in any form they choose. When I was involved with the spirit realm, I personally saw spirits appear in the form of angels, humans, animals, and inanimate objects. One even appeared to me as Jesus.

One woman I worked with had spirits in association with a pixie stone her grandmother had given her. This small pixie stone had been kept in a basket with other stones, and spirits had transferred to each of the stones the pixie stone had touched. The woman had spirits in association with all of them.

Bible Roulette (sometimes called Bibliomancy): Many people play Bible Roulette in hopes of gaining inspiration or insight from God regarding their everyday lives. These people have no idea they're dabbling in the occult.

Bible Roulette is what it's called when a person lets a Bible fall open, then lets his gaze fall on the page to obtain a message. The reason this is of the occult is that it's a form of divination, and divination is forbidden in the Bible. The demonic spirits I have

encountered when working with harassment victims who've played Bible roulette have appeared to be spirits of a lesser rank in that they have all gone easily, with only very mild manifestations. Some types of occult activities appear to rate more spirit clout than others.

Bleach or Salt Water used for driving out demons:

There have been reports in the news of women having bathed their children in bleach or salt water in order to drive out the demons they believed to be present.

I worked with a family whose children's birth mother had bathed her daughters in bleach because spirits had told her the girls were possessed and this was the only way to drive out the demons.

When I addressed any spirits who had come into the girls' lives as a result of this horrific experience, spirits manifested by appearing in the form of their birth mother and touching them all over their bodies.

Blessed Crucifix or Religious Medals worn, carried, or hung in a vehicle for protection:

When something is of the occult, it doesn't matter whether it's a religious item or not. Many people wear crucifixes that have been blessed by a priest for protection. Even if this wasn't the purpose of the blessing, people often assign the power themselves by virtue of wearing the crucifix with the belief that it will protect them.

It's been my experience in helping harassment victims break free that anything used for protection has had demonic spirits attached.

Bloody Mary:

I'm referring here to the childhood game of standing in front of a mirror and saying "Bloody Mary" several times, then turning around a specified number of times before looking into the mirror again in hopes of seeing the face of a murderess known as "Bloody Mary."

Children who have played this game typically have demonic spirits in their lives as a result.

Blood Brothers or Blood Sisters:

Demonic spirits have manifested in association with harassment victims' having cut themselves and exchanged blood with friends to become blood brothers or blood sisters (like in Western movies).

Given that this is not a common thing to do in, I've only run into it once. I have no way of knowing whether Tom got the spirits from doing the blood brother ritual, or whether Jason already had spirits from another cause, and some of them transferred to Tom.

Blood Transfusions:

Blood transfusions are a modern day miracle, and are often necessary for saving lives. But it's been my experience that spirits can transfer through blood if the blood comes from a person who has links to the occult.

Anyone who has to have a blood transfusion would be well advised to pay attention to whether strange things start happening in the aftermath. If they do, the person will need to address any spirits that came with the blood and take the appropriate steps to get rid of them.

Buddha statues:

We see them everywhere: curio stores, gift shops, Chinese restaurants... I'm talking about the cute little Buddha statues that many people have sitting on a shelf in their home.

Most harassment victims have been shocked to learn that these Buddha statues bring spirits with them. One lady I worked with told me that after she'd gotten rid of the statue in her book case and the spirits that had come with it had been cast away, the atmosphere in her home grew lighter.

Cadaverous Tissue:

I've had personal experience with this one. Several years ago, I had cadaverous tissue inserted in my body when I had surgery. (It was a choice of pig tissue or cadaverous, so I chose the cadaverous.) Soon after my surgery I began tripping and falling – not everyday, but three or four times a month. Some of these falls resulted in injuries. The worst two injured my shoulder and broke my wrist.

When I addressed any spirits that might be causing me to trip and fall, nothing manifested. Then my husband mentioned the cadaverous tissue. When he did, spirits immediately began to manifest by causing

my breath to come in huge gulps and turning my eyes temporarily black.

As I attempted to say the words to cast out any spirits that had come with the cadaverous tissue, they took my voice away. My husband commanded the “dumb” spirit in the name of Jesus to let me speak. At that point, I was able to speak and cast the spirits away.

Once the spirits from the cadaverous tissue were gone, tripping and falling were no longer a problem. It’s my belief that the reason spirits came with the cadaverous tissue was that the donor had been into some aspect of the occult.

I now have reason to believe spirits come with *any* cadaverous tissue, presumably because, according to the Bible, our bodies are a temple of the Holy Spirit, I don’t think God objects, if it’s a necessary medical procedure. But demonic spirits use it as a excuse to come into people’s lives.

The spirits who come as a result, however, can be cast away through God in Jesus’ name.

Close Proximity:

A woman I worked with had a “pixie stone” her grandmother had given her. When spirits attached to the pixie stone were addressed, several spirits made their presence known. But it didn’t stop there. This stone had been kept in a basket with several other keepsakes. Some items in the basket were in direct contact with the pixie stone, and others were not. There were spirits attached to every item that had come into contact with the stone.

I shared this information with another woman I'd become friends with as a result of having worked with her. *(I had trained this woman in doing spirit cast away through God in Jesus' name. This woman had a Native American ring in a little cedar chest with several other items of personal value. When she addressed the Native American ring, spirits manifested by giving her a sneezing fit. When she addressed items that had come in contact with the ring (as I had personally taught her to do), spirits manifested by making her sneeze for those as well.

Candles to determine presence of spirits:

Psychics and spirit guides often tell people to light candles in their home to determine whether or not evil spirits are present. Supposedly, if an evil spirit is in the room the candle flame will flicker. I can't believe I actually fell for that when I was involved with the spirit realm.

The psychic who first introduced me to my spirit guides had a wand of some sort that looked from across the room as if it were filled with glitter floating in water. She would point this wand and shake it any time the candle flame flickered. She wouldn't tell me at the time what this was all about, but I know now this was her way of attempting to cast out demonic spirits.

In addition to assigning a power of warning to the candle, she had assigned a power of protection to the wand.

The idea that candle flames flicker to warn us of the presence of demonic spirits is ludicrous. If they DO appear to do this, it's merely a game demonic spirits play. I know for a fact that the presence of demonic spirits does not have to affect the candle flame. When I was involved with spirit guides, I had candles burning all the time in my home. The candles didn't flicker. But my guides turned out to be demons.

Candles used in magic rituals:

When candles are used in conjunction with a spells or magic ritual, demonic spirits come in association with the candle – independent of the spirits that come as a result of the ritual and each of the spells.. I know this from the harassment victims I've worked with who have used candles in this way.

Christian Science Church:

Although I've never worked directly with a member of the Christian Science Church, I'm certain that membership in this church opens the door to demonic harassment.

Mary Baker Eddy, founder of the Christian Science Church is reputed to have been a spiritist. The Christian Science Church teaches that evil does not exist, thereby negating the atonement for our sins that Jesus provided when He died on the cross. Belonging to a church of false doctrine invites demonic spirits.

Crystal ball:

Gazing into a crystal ball in an effort to tell one's fortune may sound innocent enough, but it can be dangerous.

Crystal balls are a form of divination. As I've said many times, divination is forbidden in the Bible. As such, it invites demonic harassment.

A woman I worked with had gone to a fortune teller who used a crystal ball to tell fortunes. During the session, this woman saw what appeared to be the spirit of a young girl float out of the crystal ball and waft toward her! The fortune teller told Betty it was the spirit of a twelve-year-old girl named Cassandra.

In a panic, Betty went to her pastor and told him what had happened. The pastor told her she was possessed by this spirit and there was nothing he could do to help her because she was surrounded by negative energy. Next Betty made an appointment with a psychiatrist.

After several sessions, the doctor determined that Betty was a victim of MPD (multiple personality disorder) and that the alternate personality was that of a twelve-year-old girl named Cassandra.

When Betty contacted me, I took her through my list of things that invite demonic harassment and led her through the necessary prayers of rejection and denunciation. Then, through God in Jesus' name, I cast the Cassandra spirit out of her. Betty saw the spirit that had come from the crystal ball float out of her chest and across the room.

She chased the spirit into the bathroom and saw it disappear into the mirror.

Cult or Gang Membership:

Cults typically involve occult practices that invite demonic spirits into the lives of their members and into the lives of their offspring. Membership in a violent or supremacist gang or organization such as the Ku Klux Klan or the Nazi Party has the same result.

An example of this is the girl who got spirits from having a close relationship with her uncle who was a Hell's Angel.

Her uncle had never molested her or abused her in any way. But he had spirits as a result of his membership in Hell's Angels, and some of the spirits he had in *his* life transferred to his niece..

Cursing God, or saying you hate Him:

In the spirit realm, words are extremely important. When I was involved with spirit guides, a spirit professing to be Satan offered to make me rich beyond my wildest dreams. All I would have to do was say I loved him. I replied that I didn't love him, but the spirit said I didn't have to mean it. All I had to do was say the words. Saying I loved Satan would have condemned me in God's eyes.

Why, conversely, would God look with any more favor on a person who cursed Him or told Him she hated Him?

Desecrating a Church:

I worked with a man who as a teen had vandalized a church with his friends. As a result, he had spirits for each thing he'd done: one group for destroying the

hymnals, another for telling dirty jokes from the pulpit, and still another for urinating in the sanctuary.

Deception:

The children on the T.V. program Psychic Kids are a prime example of demonic deception opening the door for more demonic spirits to come in.

These children, and the children who appeared on Larry King Live on July 10, 2008 are victims of demonic harassment, and they and their parents have been deceived into believing this harassment is a gift from God.

Spirits are appearing to these kids in the form of shadow figures, orbs, and apparitions of the dead. These spirits are talking to them, giving them prophetic dreams, keeping them awake at night, and terrifying them with apparitions such as a severed hand scratching outside the window. These things aren't a gift from God. They're typical types of demonic harassment!

I've worked with many kids who had exactly the same type of things going on, only they didn't look at it as a gift. When the spirits doing the harassing had been cast away, the harassment for *these* children came to an end.

It wouldn't work to cast the spirits away from the children I saw on T.V. unless they could be convinced that these spirits were demons and *needed* to be cast away. The reason for this is that when a person *wants* a spirit in his life, that spirit has a right to stay.

Demonic Films:

I've worked with numerous people who've brought spirits into their lives through watching demonic movies such as Chucky, Bride of Chucky, The Exorcist, or Nightmare on Elm Street. The same is true of films about serial killers, vampires, or mediums.

Demonic games such as Dungeons and Dragons:

I once worked with an harassment victim who, among other things, had a spirit in association with the character he played in Dungeons and Dragons. The spirit didn't manifest when only the game was mentioned. It wasn't until we gave the name of the character that the spirit could be cast away.

Demonic video games:

A teen-aged girl I worked with had a dark figure that used to come into her room at night and stand next to her bed. One night when she refused to look at it, this spirit bent her finger back to the point that she feared it would break.

When we addressed any demonic spirit that had come into this girl's life in association with the violent video games she often played, spirits manifested. The girl disposed of the video games and did the necessary prayers of rejection and denunciation, then through God in Jesus' name, I cast the spirits away.

That was the last of the spirit that used to come into her room at night.

Dream catchers:

Parents often purchase Native American dream catchers to hang in their child's room to prevent them from having nightmares.

What these parents don't realize is that by hanging a dream catcher in their child's room they have invited additional demonic spirits into their own lives and into the life of their child.

Without exception when I've worked with an harassment victim who owns one or more dream catchers, demonic spirits have manifested for each and every one.

My husband brought spirits into our home by keeping the dream catcher key chains we received in the mail.

Drug Addiction:

Demonic spirits often get involved when a person takes recreational drugs or is addicted to drugs. I worked with a lady who had demonic spirits in her life both as a result of her addiction, and in association with her drug dealers.

The manifestation for the second dealer was much stronger than the manifestation for the first. When I asked the woman if she had any idea why this would be, she said that the second drug dealer had raped her.

Eastern and other non-Christian Religions:

I worked with a family from the Middle East who had tried every known religion except Christianity in an effort to put an end to the demonic harassment they

were experiencing. Each religion they'd tried, prior to Christianity, only made matters worse.

When it comes to dealing with demonic harassment there simply is no other answer. A belief in God and in Jesus as His son are pre-requisites.

Egyptian Jewelry with pagan charms, and other pagan items:

I've worked with two women who had demonic spirits in association with Egyptian jewelry that had pagan charms, and other pagan items from Egypt, as well as a third who used the Egyptian Eye of Horus for protection.

One had furnished her living room with Egyptian décor, including several pagan items. Spirits manifested for the pictures on her walls and for the pagan knickknacks she had placed on a bookshelf and on the end stand by her sofa. The second woman had all sorts of necklaces and bracelets that were comprised of pagan charms. She had actually taken the charms from one bracelet and attached each charm to a chain to form a variety of pendants. Demonic spirits manifested in association with every one of the charms.

The third woman had only the Eye of Horus. Her fiancé had hung it over the entry door to her apartment. When she climbed onto a chair to take it down, the spirits attached to the Eye of Horus nearly knocked her off the chair.

Energized Crystals:

Crystals that have had energy called into them have spirits attached. The same is true of crystals that have had powers assigned.

When I was involved with the spirit realm, my so-called guides told me to buy amethyst crystals and call energy into them, then place them into a Protection box with notes identifying everything I wanted to have protected. These “guides” who swore they were of God turned out to be demons. Demonic spirits wouldn’t have advised calling energy into crystals for protection if this were truly going to protect me from demons.

Interestingly enough, when my husband and I were transporting this protection box and its contents to a site where we planned to dispose of it as part of our plan for breaking free of the spirit realm, the box heated up in my lap!

A few months after we had disposed of the crystals, we received an updated list in the mail of haunted locations in and around Sacramento. The site where we had dumped our crystals had been added to the list. If ever I needed proof that demonic spirits “attach themselves” to inanimate objects, this was it.

Energy Grids:

A lady I worked with who was the victim of perhaps the worst demonic harassment I’ve yet encountered acquired many of the harassing spirits from calling energy into quartz crystals, then arranging them in a pentagram to form a “grid” of energy. She then sat

inside the pentagram energy grid and played Native American music on a ceremonial flute.

She had demonic spirits in association with (1) calling the energy into the quartz crystals (2) having constructed the pentagram with the crystals (3) for having sat inside the pentagram, (4) for the particular Native American music she chose to play, and (5) for having played the Native American ceremonial flute.

The reason this woman had so many spirits in association with this ritual was that it involved aspects of Satanism, New Age AND a spiritist culture.

Energy Pyramids:

When I was involved with New Age spirit guides, a Native American woman taught me to construct an “energy pyramid” by calling energy into amethysts and placing them in various locations throughout my house. Supposedly, living and/or working in an energy pyramid was going to make everything in my life go better. Wrong.

Constructing that energy pyramid simply invited more demonic spirits into my life.

After my spirit guides had revealed their true identity as demons, my husband and I dismantled the energy pyramid as one small step in breaking free. When my husband took the “apex” amethyst out of the battery-operated smoke alarm in the hallway, a charge of electricity coursed through his arm from his fingertips to his shoulder and continued to shock him till he’d taken the amethyst outside and disposed of it in the trash.

Fortune Telling:

Fortune telling of any kind -- whether tea leaves, cards, or a crystal ball – is divination. And divination of any type is of the occult and invites demonic spirits.

Based on my experience, spirits appear to have the ability to see several years into the future. This is why they're able to make accurate predictions through the psychics they work with.

Free Masonry (not brick layers):

Free Masons do a lot of good in the world. But what most people (even lower level Masons) aren't aware of is that Masonry is linked to the occult.

Some of the worst harassment cases I've worked with involve people who have free Masonry in their ancestry. The reason for this is that free Masonry has secret words, oaths, rituals and curses at every level that are of the occult. Many of these curses involve physical and mental health.

A man we'll call Fred had symptoms of A.L.S. that were caused by spirits that had come down through his ancestry from his grandfather who was a Mason.

Fortunately I had a list of the curses at each level of Masonry. When I addressed the curse involving the nervous system, there was a large manifestation. Through God in Jesus' name, I broke the curse, then went on to address spirits responsible for each of Fred's symptoms. As the spirits were cast out through God in Jesus' name, Fred's symptoms disappeared.

I'm not saying that all cases of A.L.S. involve demonic spirits. But at least some do.

Garlic or other herbs for protection:

An elderly couple who moved into a “haunted” house asked their friends and relatives what could be done to rid their house of the “ghosts” harassing them. One suggestion was to hang a bulb of garlic above the door. They did, and this invited additional spirits because they had assigned a power of protection to the garlic.

Ghost Hunting:

It is amazing to me how many people I've come in contact with who have actually gone “ghost hunting,” and now they're wondering why they have demonic spirits in their lives.

Shows about paranormal investigations are among the most popular shows on T.V. But I find them to be very upsetting – not because they scare me (They don't.) but because I know millions of people who are watching them are believing the things they say. Knowing what I do of the spirit realm and spirits in general, I find them to be ludicrous.

In a typical episode of one of these programs, two or three investigators accompanied by a *psychic* will go into a building with their investigative equipment to test for “energy” that might indicate the presence of a spirit. Perhaps the needle on their machine will be more active in one corner of a room than another. This will bring forth some official sounding explanation such as “I'm detecting a small amount of energy in this area -- hardly enough to register, but it's definitely

here. This could be an indication a spirit has passed through.”

Tension mounts as the investigators proceed to another room, and suddenly the needle on the machine goes wild!

“We appear to have found something,” the first investigator says. I can sense a presence, and the air here is colder than in the other rooms.”

Another investigator comments, “Yes. I feel it too?”

At this point the psychic joins in. “I’m getting that it’s the spirit of a young woman. Her name was – I can’t quite get her name, but it starts with a D – possibly Dolly, or Dorothy...No. It’s Dottie. Her name was Dottie.”

More tension mounts as a spirit continues to speak to the psychic telepathically. “She’s telling me she died here. It was an accident, but her family thinks it was suicide.” Pause...“She wants her family to know she didn’t kill herself.” Pause...“Her voice is getting faint. She’s trying to tell me her parent’s names, but I can’t understand what she’s saying.” At this point, the activity on the dial is barely existent. “It’s no use,” the psychic says. “I’ve lost her.”

“We appear to have lost Dottie,” the investigator says to the camera. Then, to the psychic, “The fact that she couldn’t give you her parents’ names will make it more difficult to track them down. Hopefully the current owners of the house will be able to shed some light.”

The investigators move on to another room, and the show breaks for a commercial.

I said earlier that to me this whole thing is a joke. My reason for saying this is that these investigators have no idea what they're dealing with. Spirits are playing games with them. These aren't the spirits of people who've died! They're demonic spirits pretending to be ghosts. They're intentionally making their presence felt. They're making the air cold for effect. They may even touch one of the investigators to startle her, or throw something across the room to give the T.V. audience a thrill.

Thrill seekers who watch these programs often want to experience this for themselves. They don't have expensive equipment for ghost hunting, so they go to a cemetery at night. (After all, this is what they've seen in the movies.) They may or may not find anything there, depending on the whim of the spirits. Or maybe a spirit will make a sound or brush against the person's cheek.

At this point, the amateur ghost hunters will normally hightail it home, deliciously scared but unharmed. They've had an exciting experience, and no harm has been done. Or has it?

The very act of ghost hunting, whether any spirits made their presence felt or not, brings demonic spirits into the lives of the ghost hunters and into the lives of their family.

Guardian Angel figure:

Guardian Angel figures or other items such as St. Christopher medals hung in a vehicle for protection are of the occult in that they assign a power to the item suspended from the mirror or visor. Anything that is of the occult brings with it demonic spirits.

I discovered this by chance when I was working with a woman who had cut ties with everything imaginable that could have opened the door to harassment, but she was still being harassed. Finally my husband asked if perhaps she had something hanging in her car to protect the traveler. I asked her, and she said she did have a guardian angel figure hanging from her rearview mirror. After the guardian angel had been disposed of and the spirits linked to it had been cast away through God in Jesus' name, the harassment ended.

Hands-On Healing That Involves Negative Energy:

Hands-on healing that involves the pulling out of pain in the form of negative energy is of the occult. The power to do this comes from demonic spirits.

When I was involved with New Age spirit guides, one of my guides trained me in hands-on healing. I would pull pain out of people's bodies in the form of negative energy. The energy would respond like an elastic band, pulling out then in, then out again, until it would eventually snap loose and the pain would be gone. The energy would coat my hands and forearms with the feeling of cobwebs, and I would have to go outside to brush it off.

When after seven years my healing guide revealed his true identity as a demon, he took the healing power away.

The healing power had not come from God. It had come from demonic forces.

Anyone who attempts to do this, or who allows this to be done to him will bring demonic spirits into his life.

Heavy metal music:

Heavy metal music spirits tend to be among the strongest in terms of manifestations. By that I don't mean that they're stronger than God, or even stronger than other demonic spirits. But they do tend to manifest more strongly.

I worked with a man who had been seriously into heavy metal music. As the heavy metal spirits were cast away, his fiancée shot pictures with her digital camera. As the spirits from each heavy metal group (at least a dozen groups) were cast away, they chose to appear in the digital photos as orbs.

When the spirit from Ozzie Osborne's music was cast out, it appeared as an apparition resembling the Joker in Batman, standing behind the man. This spirit chose to show itself to the man's fiancée, but not to appear in a photo. This woman was a sketch artist. She drew a sketch of what she had seen and sent it to me as an e-mail attachment.

Holy Water:

The fact that holy water has been blessed by a priest and is used for protection and/or to ward off evil spirits

means that it has had a power assigned, and is therefore of the occult. (Holy water, by the way, is not Biblical.)

When I worked with a family who lived in a “haunted house,” dozens of spirits manifested as having come as a result of sprinkling the rooms and windowsills with holy water.

A woman who was being “haunted” had “painted” a holy water cross on each of her children’s foreheads to protect them. Now her kids were having demonic nightmares and seeing fleeting shadows. Each child had spirits from having a holy water cross painted on his or her forehead for protection, and there were spirits in each of their rooms as a result of their mom’s having painted a holy water cross on the doors.

Homosexual Lifestyle:

There are those who may take offense at this one, particularly since same sex marriages are now legal in some states, but it’s true nevertheless. It has been my experience with every one of the six harassment victims I’ve worked with who have been born homosexual. or experimented with homosexual relationships, that demonic spirits have manifested as either (1) causing the person to be homosexual or (2) coming into their lives as a result of a homosexual relationship.

I’m not saying *all* gays are this way due to demonic activity in their lives. What I’m saying is that, to date, this has been the case with *every gay person and every gay relationship* I’ve worked with.

Intense Interest in the spirit realm, the occult, psychic phenomena, Eastern Religion, and other aspects of the paranormal:

An interest in any of these topics will definitely draw the attention of the demonic spirits involved with each, even if the person does not follow through. More likely than not, the person will surf the web and or buy books from bookstores on the topic of interest – books that, unknown to them, come with demonic spirits attached.

This goes along with what my former spirit guides said about demonic spirits hanging around in bookstores watching for people to buy books on these topics so they could go home with them.

Unfortunately, the mere act of researching these topics can bring demonic spirits into the life of the researcher.

Websites that are of the occult also have spirits “attached” that transfer from the website to site visitors. The same is true films.

Jehovah’s Witness Church:

An harassment victim I once worked with had a heavy weight on his shoulders that was caused by demonic spirits that had come as a result of his membership in this church and his belief in the false doctrine that Jesus is the archangel Michael.

When my husband and I were clearing spirits from our own lives several years ago, one spirit that was still with my husband was one that had come from a

Jehovah's witness who came to his door and actually tried to *break in* when he said he didn't want the Watch Tower!

Kochina dolls:

Demonic spirits have manifested in association with kochina dolls. One family had a grandfather living with them who had collection of kochina dolls. Bad things were happening in their home and in their lives.

The grandfather wouldn't believe me when I told him the dolls were of the occult, and he wasn't willing to consider getting rid of them. So I advised this family to move all the dolls to the grandfather's room and reject and denounce any connection with them or with the spirits attached to them. Once these things had been done and the Kochina Doll spirits harassing them had been cast away, the family (other than the grandfather) had no further spirit problems.

Kinesiology:

Although some forms and aspects of kinesiology are legit, certain forms are of the occult.

When I went to a chiropractor who, in addition to doing chiropractic treatments, had a method of testing for allergies (This was before I began working with harassment victims and my knowledge of spirits and the occult were not yet fully developed.) this doctor asked me to hold various bottles of herbs in my left hand and extend my left arm.

As I was holding each bottle, he attempted to press my arm down, the idea being that if my arm went

down easily it would mean that I was allergic to that herb. If it was hard to press down, I wasn't allergic.

With each herb I held, not only did my arm go down, but it took my entire body with it. Finally the doctor said "Would you please stop that?" He was talking to me, but apparently the spirit that was pushing me responded. From that point on, my arm held firm no matter what herb I was holding.

Every harassment victim I've worked with who has had this sort of muscle testing used on him has had a spirit manifestation for kinesiology.

In the case of a doctor who used this sort of testing to determine the appropriate medications for children suffering from Autism, this doctor had the father hold the child on his lap and hold the medication in *his* hand. He then extended his arm for the doctor to do the test.

This man and his daughter both had spirits in their lives as a result. As they were cast away through God in Jesus' name, they manifested by giving the man a headache which instantly disappeared when the last of the spirits were gone,

Lighter than Air:

This is a levitation game often played by both children and adults. Another name for it is Light as a Feather.

One man I worked with said his spirit problems had first begun when he and some friends played lighter than air as adults.

Listening Willingly to False Doctrine:

When my husband and I listened recently to a televangelist advocating the donation of large sums of money to the church in the expectation of receiving rewards from God, spirits came to both of us and had to be cast away.

This pastor told the story of when “God spoke” to him saying to give, in order to receive. According to his story, this pastor truly believed it was God who was speaking to him. He did what he believed God had told him to do. And pretty soon two separate people handed him hundred dollar bills with the explanation that God had told *them* to bless him by giving him this money.

Encouraged by this return on his investment, the pastor began donating hundred dollar bills on a regular basis and receiving hundreds of dollars in return. Then came the day that he needed a new suit, and planned to spend one or two of the bills to purchase it. Again “God” spoke and told him to donate the money. He did, and soon after that, a couple approached him and said “God” had “told” them to treat him as their own son. In response, they wanted to buy him a suit. For the next several years, this couple provided new suits to the pastor on a regular basis.

In the meantime, the pastor was saving hundred dollar bills. When his cache had reached a thousand dollars, “God” told him to give it to the church. He very grudgingly made the donation. As a matter of fact, he said it made him sick to have to donate that much money. But he made the donation. Days later, he

received a royalty check of \$3000 for a song he had written.

This pastor told these stories as examples of God's generosity to people who give to the church. But his stories were interspersed with comments on how he'd given the money against his will and been rewarded by "God" for his gifts. He even made the comment that it's easier to love others when you have money.

This pastor was an excellent speaker and I truly enjoyed his sermon. But I knew beyond the shadow of a doubt that God had not spoken to this pastor or to any of the people who said God had told them to give him money. I knew it because every harassment victim I've worked with who has ever told me God spoke to him has had demonic spirits manifest as having pretended to be God. Also, during my former deliverance ministry, I worked hand in hand with God, Jesus, and the Holy Spirit, casting out demons for the harassment victims I worked with. God was with me every step of the way, but He never once spoke to me. Neither did Jesus or the Holy Spirit.

When I was involved with New Age spirit guides who turned out to be demons, however, a demonic spirit did speak to me pretending to be God. The demonic spirits acting as my guides encouraged *me* to spend beyond my means, just as the spirit pretending to be God had done with this pastor.

I believe *demonic spirits* encouraged this pastor to spend, AND provided the pay back to keep him involved with talking to and obeying this spirit who *pretends* to be God.

Magick, black or white:

I'm not talking here about magic that involves sleight of hand or tricks such as sawing a woman in half or pulling a rabbit out of a hat.

I'm talking about magick that calls upon supernatural powers. (Note: the spelling of magick with a k is intentional. This is the spelling for magic that is of the occult.)

I was horrified to hear that a Sunday School teacher had recommended that the children in his Sunday School class watch the movie Harry Potter.

It is my belief that the Harry Potter books and films have done more than any of us will ever know to bring children into witchcraft. Magick, whether black or white, draws its power from demonic sources, and automatically brings demonic spirits and harassment into the life of the person using the magick, even if that person is a child.

Masturbation:

Masturbation won't make a person cross-eyed as mothers used to tell their sons, but it will bring spirits into his life – or into hers, if we're talking about a girl. A person who is addicted to masturbation needs to address the spirits who've come with the masturbation, spirits that have come with any sex toys involved, and spirits who have caused or contributed to the addiction.

I hadn't been aware that masturbation invited demonic spirits until I was working with an

harassment victim who had a possessive group of spirits that identified themselves as “Masturbation.” Since that time, for every harassment victim I’ve worked with who has admitted to ever having masturbated, spirits have manifested in association with that masturbation, as well as for each of the tools that were used. In the case of one teen, there were spirits of masturbation who had claimed possession of the *finger* she used to stimulate herself!

Membership in the Ku Klux Klan, Skin Heads, Bloods, Hell’s Angels, or similar organizations:

Although I haven’t worked with Klan members themselves, I have worked with descendants of Klan members who have spirits in their lives to show for their ancestor’s involvement in the Klan. And although I haven’t worked with gang members or their offspring, I’m certain the same is true of them.

I have also worked with blacks who had spirits passed down through their ancestry in association with parents or grandparents having been beaten, mutilated, or killed by the Klan.

Moving Into a House or Apartment that already has resident spirits:

Often people who have never had spirit problems before, acquire them when they move into a home where spirits are already present.

Mormonism:

Joseph Smith who founded the Mormon Church got much of the Mormon doctrine from a set of secret tablets provided by a spirit (angel) named Moroni. Smith found the tablets through use of a peep stone.

He would place the peep stone into a hat, then cover his eyes with the hat. Through this method he would have a vision such as the one that told him where to find the gold tablets.

These tablets, by the way, no longer exist. In one version of the story, Smith claimed to have given them back to Moroni.

Former Mormons I've worked with have had spirit manifestations in association with (1) each of the Mormon secret rituals and each of the secret signs (3) the Mormon belief that the Mormon prophet is the earthly representative of God, and (3) in association with the false doctrine that God was once as we are, and we will someday be as gods. Those who have believed that Jesus and Satan were brothers have had spirit manifestations in conjunction with this belief.

Note: Mormon symbols are almost identical to the symbols of free Masonry, due to the fact that Joseph Smith was a Mason.

Native American, and other spiritist ancestry:

Despite the fact that the Native American culture is rich in historical value, the fact that it is a *spiritist* culture accounts for the fact that harassment victims with Native American ancestry are normally able to trace at least part of the spirit harassment they're experiencing back to their ancestors and spiritist heritage. The same is true of other religions that involve prayers to anyone other than the Christian God.

Native American ceremonial items and rituals of protection:

Items used or intended for use in spiritist ceremonies bring with them demonic spirits and harassment. Native American peace pipes are an example.

My husband and I had a Sioux peace pipe hanging on the wall in our living room for years. It never occurred to us that it could be the source of many of the problems we were experiencing.

Then one morning when we were at McDonald's for breakfast, I mentioned that the peace pipe had been on my mind and I thought we needed to get rid of it. My husband said he'd been thinking the same thing.

That day when we went home, my husband built a fire in the wood burning stove, then took the peace pipe down off the wall. Immediately, he began to feel sick. I shot digital photos as he broke the peace pipe and fed it into the fire.. Halfway through, he had to sit down. He said he felt as if he were going to die. I immediately did a cast away of any spirit or spirits making him feel this way, and the morbid feeling left him.

As he continued feeding pieces of the peace pipe into the fire, he noticed a feather that had floated to the floor. When he bent to pick up the feather, he nearly passed out.

Later when we called up the digital photos in our computer, the ones involving the peace pipe were filled with orbs. In all, we counted 33. (Spirits often choose to appear as orbs, particularly in digital

photos. These orbs often appear in groups that are a multiple of three.

Unfortunately, many things in the Native American culture are done or made for protection or for the purpose of driving out evil spirits. For this reason (since a power has been assigned), demonic spirits are attached – even if the item has never been used for the purpose for which it was created.

For the person with Native American ancestry, any of these things he or she has owned, and any spiritist ceremonies he or she has taken part in must be addressed individually if that person is to break of the spirits who came as a result.

I find it interesting that my website page on spiritist cultures got “unpublished” after I had published it. (Apparently the spirits I’m writing about didn’t want people to read the information contained in that page.) I wouldn’t have discovered it if I hadn’t checked my counter and discovered no one was visiting the page.

Obscene Comments about God or Jesus:

Many comedians and would-be comedians think it’s funny to poke fun or make lewd comments about God or Jesus. What they don’t realize is that by doing this they’re opening the door for spirits to come in. Demonic spirits love it when we blaspheme or otherwise make a mockery of God.

The same is true of people who routinely use phrases such as “Ch - -st on a hickory crutch.”

Opening the Mind:

Any time a person opens his mind through yoga, meditation, hypnosis, or other means, he runs the risk of having demonic spirits enter. Many harassment victims I've worked with have brought spirits into their lives as a result of opening their minds.

Some have had spirits speak through them in the process of hypnosis. I saw a true story on T.V. about a man whose daughters had no memory of being molested. Physical exams showed no evidence of molestation. Yet, under hypnosis both girls accused their father of raping them.

As a result of their testimony, their father went to prison, despite his protestations of innocence and the fact that there was no evidence to support the charges. I have often wondered if demonic spirits planted false memories in the girls' minds.

Occult Treatment of Autism:

In a case in which occult kinesiology (holding a medication in one hand, and extending the arm for the doctor to press down) was used to determine their child's medication for Autism, both parents had spirit manifestations as a result of having allowed occult means to be used for determining their daughter's medication, and the daughter had spirits from both the kinesiology and the doctor's having meditated over her.

It should be noted that many children recover from autism as a result of doctors using meditation and this type of kinesiology to prescribe their medication. These are the ones the spirits choose to give the right

information. But the families of these children have meditation and kinesiology spirits in their home, despite the fact that their child is apparently cured. They may not realize the presence of spirits right away, but the mother of the child I worked with said that the families she knows of whose autistic children have been treated by these methods report having new problems of a different sort, as well as strange goings on in their homes.

For those who have already obtained medication for an autistic child prescribed in this way, the spirits that came as a result can be cast away. Hopefully, after this, the parents can find a doctor who doesn't use these methods of choosing medications.

Ouija Board:

Ouija Boards, whether manufactured by Parker Brothers and sold as a toy, or made at home are a direct line of communication with demonic spirits.

Prayers to God to allow only "spirits of light" to speak through it do no good. God doesn't bless things that are of the occult. And the Bible warns us not to talk to spirits or associate with people who do.

My first contact with the spirit realm was through a Ouija Board when I was in high school. Twenty-five years later, the spirit from the Ouija Board was still with me. It entered my car and spoke telepathically, saying it was the same one that had spoken to me through the Ouija Board when I was 17. (See my true story *Betrayed by Her Guardian Angel*, available through my website at staciespielman.com, and through the Kindle Store at Amazon.

A man I worked with said the Ouija spirit told him and his friends that it wanted them to murder three of their acquaintances. It even gave details of how to commit the murders and get away with it. Fortunately, these men had enough sense not to follow the spirit's instructions.

Palmistry:

If you've studied palmistry, read palms, or had your palm read, you have spirits in your life as a result. Palmistry is a form of divination, and divination in any form is of the occult.

Pendulums:

Pendulums used for answering questions are a form of spirit contact, the same as the Ouija Board. As a matter of fact, the pendulum and an alphabet arc were how I first contacted the spirit who claimed to be my guardian angel, but who turned out to be a demon.

Those who believe that the pendulum is a method of communicating with the subconscious mind are mistaken. Psychotherapists and/or psychiatrists who use pendulums or automatic writing in an effort to get in touch with the subconscious mind of their patients are inviting demonic spirits into their own life and into the lives of their patients.

Of the harassment victims I've worked with, if they've ever used a pendulum, they've had spirits in their lives as a result. Holding a pendulum over the abdomen of an expectant mom to determine the sex of the baby is no exception.

Pentagrams (wearing, constructing, or owning):

Pentagrams may seem to be innocuous, but they're a virtual magnet for demonic spirits. (See "Energy Grids.")

I once worked with a man who used to doodle pentagrams. It turned out to be a form of demonic harassment. A spirit was actually guiding his hand.

Pentecostal Churches that involve speaking in tongues:

Without exception, of the harassment victims I've worked with who have attended Pentecostal Churches and been "baptized in the holy spirit" every last one has had demonic spirits in his life as a result. This is because it's not the real Holy Spirit who speaks through the people who are baptized in these churches. The real Holy Spirit doesn't speak in a confusing tongue that no one can understand. The real Holy Spirit doesn't make fools of people by making them bark like a dog, or walk like a chicken. The real Holy Spirit doesn't throw people onto the ground or make them laugh or cry uncontrollably.

Demonic spirits pretending to be the real Holy Spirit do these things. They like nothing better than to make fools of people, and call it the work of the Holy Spirit.

One lady told me she always prayed in tongues. I asked her if she knew what she was saying. She said she had no idea. I pointed out that if this was a demonic spirit speaking through her, it might be blaspheming God, or telling Him lies. She said she

was certain it wasn't a demon, and trusted it to pray for things that were in her best interest.

I talked her into letting me address the matter this way: If there's a demonic spirit who pretends to be the real Holy

Spirit and says Marge's prayers for her at night... Immediately a demonic spirit began to manifest.

Pictures Hung for Protection or to Attract Something Into Your Life Such as Love or Prosperity;

I've worked with many harassment victims who've had pictures of Jesus hanging all through their home for the purpose of protection. In every case, these people have had demonic spirits in association with each picture. This was not because the pictures themselves were demonic. It's because by assigning the power of Protection to the pictures these people had moved the pictures of Jesus into the realm of the occult.

The same is true of harassment victims who have hung something other than a picture on their wall or bulletin board to attract something into their lives.

Pornography:

Although pornography is not of the occult, it does invite demonic spirits. This includes pornographic websites, porn videos, pornographic books, and pornographic sex acts. I've worked with many women who were victims of horrible demonic harassment due to their husbands' fascination with porn.

Prayer Cloths, Prayer Wallets, etc.:

Many televangelists offer prayer cloths, and prayer wallets in exchange for donations.

What they don't tell their viewers, and probably don't know themselves, is that each of these prayer items brings demonic spirits with it. The reason for this is that these televangelists have assigned a power to these cloths to heal whatever ails the person, and a power to the wallets to bring financial prosperity. At the risk of belaboring a point, any time a power of any kind is assigned to an item, it moves that item into the realm of the occult and invites demonic spirits.

I worked with a young man who had a prayer cloth he had donated \$25 for at a healing crusade. He said the cloth hadn't helped. As a matter of fact, his health problems had gotten worse.

He said he had soaked the prayer cloth in water and drunk the water in hopes that this would have more healing power than the prayer cloth alone. The water, rather than helping, had made him deathly ill.

After going through the usual preliminaries and having this man dispose of the prayer cloth, I cast the prayer cloth spirits away through God in Jesus' name. But the harassment didn't end, and I couldn't figure out why.

Finally the man told me he had four other prayer cloths he hadn't mentioned. Once all these prayer cloths had been destroyed and the spirits of the prayer cloths had been cast away, the harassment stopped and the young man's health improved.

A woman who contacted the ministry of televangelist Peter Popoff even had spirits that had come with the free Miracle Spring water. The reason for this was that the Miracle Spring Water had been assigned a power. She wasn't quite certain what that power was – whether the water was supposed to improve her health, or improve her finances, or both. But she definitely knew it was supposed to make her life better.

When I addressed any spirits who had come with the water, there was a large manifestation.

Praying for the gift of tongues:

Given that the Biblical speaking in tongues died out more than two thousand years ago, it stands to reason that when a person prays for the gift of tongues, this is an open invitation for a demonic spirit to speak gibberish through his mouth.

Of the dozen or more harassment victims I worked with who had spoken in tongues or had tongues spoken over them, demonic spirits have manifested in every case.

Praying to anyone other than God:

In the Bible, God says “Thou shalt have no other gods before me,” and He means it.

Praying to anyone other than God – whether it be idols, angels, pagan gods, Mary, saints, dead relatives, or even Jesus – invites demonic spirits to answer. Even if they don't answer the prayers, believe me when I say they *will come*.

Many harassment victims I've worked with have had demonic spirits manifest for their having prayed to Mary, St. Christopher, and each of the other saints. (Note: Catholic harassment victims have also had spirit manifestation as a result of confessing their sins to the priest for absolution. This is because only God is the judge, and only He can forgive our sins.)

I once worked with a woman who said she and a girlfriend had made an idol of a stuffed Garfield when they were kids. They started praying to Garfield, and their prayers were answered! They were answered by demonic spirits. These same spirits had followed both girls into adulthood.

The "Garfield idol" spirits did not leave the harassment victim I was working with until she had apologized to God and rejected and denounced (1) having made the idol, and (2) having prayed to it. Then, and only then, was I able through God in Jesus' name to cast the spirits away.

Psychic Hotline:

An harassment victim who had worked as an operator for a psychic hot line had spirits as a result of connecting the calls. I've worked with many people who've had spirits in their lives from *calling* the psychic hot line as well.

Psychic readings:

The Bible refers to psychics as soothsayers and warns us to stay away from them.

More than half of the harassment victims I've worked with had spirits they got as a result of consulting with psychics. They had at least one group who had transferred from the psychic, and another who had given the information to the psychic for the reading.

Often it is the psychic who introduces her clients to spirit guides. This was the case with me, and with a woman I worked with from Massachusetts. When I was working with this woman, suddenly these spirit guides started talking to me through her mouth, and she didn't even know they were talking. These guides told me they had no intention of leaving, claimed I had no authority over them, and said Michelle wanted them to stay.

They were right in saying I had no authority over them, but God and Jesus did, if Michelle really wanted the spirits to go. This, unfortunately, was not the case. To the best of my knowledge, the spirits are still with her. God does not force us to make the right decisions.

Reading Books on the Occult:

Reading books on various aspects of the occult and/or spiritist cultures may open the door for demonic spirits to enter your life.

When I was involved with New Age spirit guides, they told me demonic spirits like to hang out in book stores to go home with people who purchase or borrow books on the occult. The same is true of films.

Though it's true my guides turned out to be demons, they often told the truth or half truths. Based on my

experience working with harassment victims, what the spirit guides said on this issue has proven to be true. Demonic spirits either attach to the books and movies or they hang around watching till someone buys or rents them, then follow the person home. Either way, the end result is the same.

Salt Used for Protection:

The belief that demonic spirits can't cross a line of salt is a fallacy. Sprinkling salt for protection is of the occult and invites demonic spirits. The same is true of sprinkling brick dust.

A family I worked with had called in a priest to rid their home of spirits. Not only had this priest sprinkled holy water, he had given the family a container of blessed salt and told them to sprinkle salt on every windowsill, on the floor at every doorway, and to make a trail of salt around the perimeter of their house.

When I was working with this family, demonic spirits manifested in conjunction with every window sill, every doorway, and the trail of salt around the house. In short, the priest who had come to clear their house of demonic spirits had compounded the problem many times over.

Think about this, if you will. Spirits are fallen angels. They have powers second only to Jesus. Imagine how they're laughing at humans who paint their doors red, hang garlic in their doorways, hang hazelnuts in their home, or sprinkle a trail of salt to keep them out.

Not only can spirits go through walls (without benefit of doors or windows), they can move instantly from

one side of the world to another! This has been proven time and again when sprits have transferred to me (prior to my learning to do bindings in Jesus' name) as I've cast them out of people in other states and other countries. I thank God that I have the faith and knowledge that was necessary for casting these spirits away from myself, as well as others.

Santeria:

This is a semi-Catholic semi-spiritist religion that began in Cuba and spread to the U.S.

Sanitarians typically have demonic spirits in association with each of their Catholic practices and each spirit they have prayed to. These spirits are often passed down through the generations to their offspring.

Scientology:

L. Ron Hubbard, founder of Scientology, had a red-haired female spirit he believed to be his guardian angel. This spirit would ride on one of the wings of his plane. (The Bible, by the way, makes no mention of female spirits. But I know from experience that spirits can take on any appearance they choose.)

Satanist Aleister Crowley and Hubbard were close friends. Crowley referred to himself as the Anti-Christ, the Beast of Revelations, and **666**.

Regarding Scientology and L. Ron Hubbard, following is a quote from Hubbard's son in an interview with Penthouse Magazine:

“I believed in Satanism. There was no other religion in the house! Scientology® and black magick. What a lot of people don't realize is that Scientology® is black magic that is just spread out over a long time period. To perform black magic generally takes a few hours or, at most, a few weeks. But in Scientology it's stretched out over a lifetime, and so you don't see it. Black magic is the inner core of Scientology® --- and it is probably the only part of Scientology® that really works.

Also, you've got to realize that my father did not worship Satan. He thought he was Satan. He was one with Satan. He had a direct pipeline of communication and power with him. My father wouldn't have worshiped anything. I mean, when you think you're the most powerful being in the universe, you have no respect for anything, let alone worship.

Given this information, how could anyone think he could belong to the Church of Scientology without inviting demonic spirits into his life? I've often wondered about the Hollywood stars who are involved with Scientology. Even if they aren't being harassed, it has occurred to me that demonic spirits may be involved with their wealth and success (with or without their permission or knowledge).

What better way could there be for demonic forces to draw more people into the Church of Scientology (thus into the occult) than to contribute to the success of some of its members (in this case actors and actresses) who can in turn be influential in drawing more people into the church?

Séances:

It would seem to me that séances and ghost hunting would be a no brainer. But they don't appear to be.

There's something about the idea of spirits and being "deliciously scared" that appeals to people of all ages – sort of like the roller coaster at a carnival. This is the reason many *kids* conduct séances and don't tell their parents.

For adults, there's normally a different motivation. Adults legitimately desire contact with friends and relatives who've passed on. They want to be reassured that their dead loved ones are ok, and they want to know what life is like on the other side. But regardless of what the motivation, calling on spirits and talking to them brings them into your life, regardless of age or religious affiliation.

I worked with a lady we'll call Carol whose sister and her friends had held a séance in which Carol's sister (who didn't like baby-sitting for Carol) gave Carol to Satan! As a result, Carol became possessed. Her childhood and most of her adult life were dominated by demonic harassment. She couldn't even go out in public without having the spirits take control of her muscles.

As I was casting the spirits out through God in Jesus' name, one of them spoke to me through Carol and said Carol's mother had given her to Satan. This caused a good bit of confusion until it was revealed that her sister had, in effect, been forced to take on the role of her mother.

After the possessive spirits had been cast away through God in Jesus' name, Carol had no further problem with her muscles.

Second Hand Items and/or hand-me-downs:

If you have purchased any used items or received any as hand-me downs, there is the chance of having received spirits with them if the person who owned them before you had any links to the occult.

A woman who had taken care of her chronically ill mother in her home inherited her mother's belongings by default when her mother died without leaving a will. It happened that this woman's mother had been mean, vindictive, and bent on destroying her relationship with her husband and children. The mother had also been selfish and possessive, and had issued instructions that no one but her was ever to sleep in her canopied bed. In essence, she had put a word curse on the bed.

Spirits were attached to the bed frame, the mattress, the bed linens, the comforter, and the canopy. Spirits were also attached to a scarf this woman had made for her granddaughter's teddy bear, using fabric from one of the grandmother's garments.

Self-Hypnosis Recordings and Hypnotherapy:

A couple I worked with had used self-hypnosis cd's to help them lose weight and stop snoring. She didn't lose weight, and he didn't stop snoring. But both of them got spirits in their lives, and the harassment that comes with him.

Spirits manifested for their having purchased the c.d.'s, for their having used the c.d.'s and opened their minds, and as having transferred to both them and the bureau drawer the tapes had been stored in.

Note: By part of the group transferring to the drawer, the spirits established a remote location from which they could harass this couple even after the spirits who had transferred to *them* had been cast away.

Seventh Day Adventist Church:

The Adventist Church got much of its doctrine from spiritist Ellen G. White (E.G. White), or egg white as my husband refers to her. Ms. White had a spirit (angel) that used to visit her every night and dictate what she was to write. Much of what this spirit dictated made its way into Ms. White's books, and into the doctrine of what was to become the Seventh Day Adventist Church.

This Church, by the way, has its own version of the Bible complete with excerpts from Ellen G. White's "Spirit of Prophecy."

When my husband and I visited the house that was once Ellen White's home, we brought a spirit group home with us that had to be cast away. My husband recalls that when he was a member of the Adventist Church, many of the church members had stories they would exchange about spirit harassment in their own homes.

Sex partners:

The Bible says we are one with anyone we have lain with. I have found it to be true of harassment victims

I've worked with, that demonic spirits have transferred to them from sex partners who'd dabbled in any aspect of the occult. (In addition, if they haven't been married to their sex partners, they've had spiritual entities of Fornication.)

One man we'll call Tom had many spirits that had come to him from sleeping with a bi-sexual woman. This woman had spirits from both male and female partners in addition to spirits from lesbian affairs. Since spirits work in very large groups, this woman still had plenty of spirits left over after some of them transferred to Tom.

Signs and Omens:

Looking for signs and omens is a type of divination and brings spirits into the person's life as a result. This may not happen immediately. But if a person makes a habit of looking for signs and omens, and lives his life according to their dictates, sooner or later it will attract demonic attention, and spirits will become involved.

Smudging:

This is a method people often use for purification, and in an effort to protect themselves from evil spirits. Smudging originated with the Native American culture. Native Americans use many different herbal blends for this purpose.

Sage is used in witchcraft for smudging, and is often recommended by spirit guides and psychics.

Many people use incense for the same purpose. Far from keeping spirits out, however, herbs and incense

used for purification or protection merely bring more spirits in.

Sodomy:

Sodomy (anal intercourse), whether consensual or not, and regardless of whether it's done by a man and woman or a homosexual couple, brings with it demonic spirits.

Having sex with a person who has had sex with another partner who has ever been involved with sodomy also brings sodomy spirits to the “innocent partner” who has never taken part in sodomy herself.

Stripping and Lap dancing:

I've only worked with one stripper, but I'm certain this would apply to all. This former stripper had spirits that manifested as having come from stripping, acting out a lesbian skit on stage, and doing lap dances. She also had adulterous spirits that had come to her from married men who'd solicited her services while they were married.

In the process of breaking free from the spirits in his life, a man who had gone to a strip club but had *never had a lap dance*, had spirits manifest for going to the strip club *and for a lap dance*. He asked me if the spirits could have come to him from his *buddy's* having a lap dance. I asked the man if he'd paid for the lap dance, encouraged it, applauded, or been turned on by it.

The answer to all these questions was “No,” but the spirits continued to manifest. Finally, I asked if the man had tried to stop his buddy from having the lap

dance. He hadn't. So I addressed the spirits in this way: "In the name of Jesus, son of God, if any spirits feel they have a stronghold with Bill because he didn't try to talk his buddy out of having the lap dance..." That turned out to be the key. Bill had known it was wrong in God's eyes to have a lap dance at a strip club, but he hadn't tried to discourage his buddy from having one. Spirits had apparently come into his life as a result.

Studying topics such as mind control:

When I was working with a woman who believed herself to be an alien abductee and a victim of mind control government experiments, she sent me an article on mind control. This article told of a doctor's experiences, reportedly following having been the subject of government mind control experiments.

Normally my husband and I don't read articles of this type. But we were reading it in hopes of getting some insight into what this woman insisted she was experiencing. As we were studying the article, multiple spirits came to each of us, as well as to us as a couple. We immediately deleted the document and did a cast away through God in Jesus' name of the spirits. When we did, both of us felt instantly lighter.

Most people would take this as a sign that all of the spirits had left. But I knew from my work with harassment victims that spirits sometimes manifest by giving a feeling of total peace or lightness to fool their victims into thinking they've all gone. We didn't succeed in getting rid of the last of the spirits until we had broken the strongholds of willingly downloading

the attachment and then studying the information the attachment contained.

Talking to the dead, even at graveside:

The Bible calls talking to the dead necromancy, and warns against it. Many harassment victims I've worked with have had spirits as a result of talking to dead relatives at graveside. Others have had spirits from talking to pictures of the deceased. Still others had spirits for talking to a dead loved one's ashes, or doing something with the ashes such as taking them for a drive because the deceased person used to enjoy drives in the country.

One family I worked with had more than sixty spirits in their home, all pretending to be the dead grandpa. The reason for appearing as "Grandpa" was that they often talked to their dead grandpa when they visited his gravesite. These Grandpa spirits would appear to the mother and daughter in the form of apparitions. One or more used to crawl into bed with the mother at night and whisper in her ear. (The real grandpa had never acted this way when he was alive. He would have been appalled if he had known demonic spirits were tormenting his grandson's wife, pretending to be him.)

Tarot cards:

Tarot cards are a form of divination that's been around since the fifteenth century. They come in all shapes and colors, and are sold in metaphysical bookstores. There's even a *round* deck!

When I was involved with New Age spirit guides, I was required by the spirits to purchase a Tarot deck

to reveal what my destiny was to be. The spirits controlled the cards so that no matter how they were dealt, the same cards would always be turned up.

As I was writing this e-book, I stopped to look up some information on the internet regarding the origin of Tarot. Multiple spirits came into my home and my computer as a result of visiting the Tarot website. Spirits, in turn, transferred to my husband and my dog. I had to do cast aways from myself, my husband, my dog, *and* my computer.

Testing Crystals to feel their energy:

When I was involved with New Age spirit guides, I was told by the spirits that I needed to put amethyst crystals throughout my house. (A Native American woman had previously taught me to use amethysts to construct an energy pyramid.) Before purchasing an amethyst, according to both the Native American and my spirit guides, I was to hold the crystal in my hand and feel the strength of its energy.

After breaking free of the spirit realm, I had occasion to visit a mineral shop and examine some amethyst crystals. Now that I was no longer involved in the occult, the crystals did not vibrate in my hand.

Torture:

Torture invites demonic spirits into the lives of both the torturer and the victim of his torture.

When I had my ministry, I worked with a woman who had a fascination with medieval torture. This woman had at least a dozen books and films involving torture. As a result of her fascination, the books, and the

films, this woman was the victim of such severe demonic harassment that she had moved more than half a dozen times in an effort to escape it. Moving had done no good. The spirits had gone with her.

After leading this woman through the necessary steps preceding spirit cast aways, I did a cast away of spirits involved with (1) this woman's fascination with torture (2) each of the torture books, and (3) each of the torture films.

As these spirits were cast away, twenty-four appeared to this woman dressed in medieval garb. As they marched through her house in single file and out through the front door, they were singing: "Good-bye, farewell. We really have to go now..." These torture spirits apparently had a sense of humor.

Traditional Deliverance Ministries:

I worked with man who had been through several deliverance ministries, but to no avail. As a matter of fact, he had more spirits now than he'd had to begin with. There were a number of reasons for this. Some members of each of the deliverance teams spoke in tongues.

(2) The deliverance minister did not require that the harassment victim cut ties with each and every link to the occult, so any spirits who left had a right to return with their friends.

(3) At least one of the deliverance ministries "baptized this man in the holy spirit," which allowed a demon masquerading as the real Holy Spirit to manifest through him and come into his life.

Note: Many deliverance ministers are unaware that spirits never work alone. They generally work in large groups that are multiples of three – sometimes very *large* multiples that go by the name of legion or military system.

Often the deliverance minister will cast out one, such as the spirit claiming to be Frank. A Frank spirit will manifest and leave. But what the deliverance minister fails to realize is that there are numerous spirits all playing the same role. When one leaves, the others remain. One family I worked with had more than sixty spirit groups all masquerading as one.

Using blessed oils for healing or protection:

Anything that has had a power assigned automatically invites demonic spirits, even if that item has been blessed by a pastor or a priest.

The Holy Oil spoken of in the Old Testament was to be used only in the temple, and applied only to members of the priesthood. The oil anointings spoken of elsewhere in the Bible were done for medicinal purposes. (The only “medicines” available at that time were olive oil and wine.)

When James said to call the elders to pray and anoint the sick person with oil, he was talking about a person who is gravely ill, and suggesting that the elders of the church be called in to do everything medically possible for the person, then pray for *God* to heal him.

Visiting Sites of Violence or Occult Activity:

When I had my ministry, I used to ask harassment victims if they'd ever worked in, been confined to, or visited a prison or mental hospital.

Of those who said they'd worked or been confined in either a prison or mental institution, demonic spirits manifested – without exception.

For those who had visited a friend or relative in prison or jail who had *no* history of violence or occult activity, there were usually no manifestations.

One family I worked with had visited Alcatraz. No spirits manifested for having visited the prison. But spirits did manifest in association with their having gone into one of the cells where a violent prisoner had been incarcerated.

A man I worked with who had been in prison had spirits that had transferred from the cell he was in (spirits left behind by evil and violent prisoners who had once inhabited the cell), spirits that had transferred from other prisoners he associated with, and spirits that had come as a result of his having been sodomized by another prisoner. He had acquired spirits both from the rapist and from the act of sodomy.

Voodoo:

A black lady I worked with in New Orleans had spirits who had been passed down from a grandmother who was into voodoo.

Since that time, I have worked with victims of voodoo curses. These are among the most difficult to deal

with, in that they involve Black Magick and all its aspects.

Wanting to Have a Paranormal Experience:

A man we'll call Bill went to a "haunted" restaurant, hoping to have a paranormal experience. He looked all around, hoping to see a "ghost" sitting in one of the booths, but was disappointed when he saw nothing out of the ordinary.

Then Bill went into the men's restroom. He was seated on "the throne" when suddenly the toilet paper began to unroll. He watched it unroll all the way to the floor. Heart thudding, he rolled the toilet paper back up and tested to make sure it was secure. A few seconds later, the toilet paper began – very slowly – to unroll again. Bill watched in morbid fascination till the t.p. reached the floor.

One of more groups of the spirits involved went home with Bob that day.

White Light:

When I was involved with New Age spirit guides, I was required by my guides to surround myself with white light at all times – but particularly when talking with a new spirit.

White light is a doctrine of demons that is being passed on to the general public by psychics and spirit guides. It is of the occult, and if it appears to work at all, this is only because the spirits are playing a game, and backing off on harassment to make the person believe the imaginary white light has the power to protect her.

When my guides eventually turned against me and revealed themselves as demons, they laughed at me for having ever believed white light could protect me.

Wind Chimes Hung for Protection:

I've never encountered an harassment victim who had spirits in association with an ordinary wind chime purchased for its beauty or melodic sound. But when a wind chime is purchased for protection, this invites demonic spirits.

Witchcraft, black or white:

The Bible warns against witchcraft, as well as against associating with witches. This is because the power of witchcraft, whether black or white, comes from demonic forces.

A teen-ager I worked with had put a love spell on a boy in her class to get him to be attracted to her. The spell worked, but as a result of it, twelve spirit groups came into this girl's life. As the spirits were cast away through God in Jesus' name, she and her mother both felt them leave.

A woman I worked with who claimed to be a Christian had been practicing witchcraft since childhood.

As a child, Martha and a friend had put a spell on a little boy in their class just to see if the spell would work. Truth be told, it was more of a curse than a spell. The intention of the spell was to make this little boy sick. The girls meant no harm: perhaps a low fever or tummy ache.

The next day the boy failed to show up for class. A week later, the girls learned that the boy had died. I'm not saying this woman and her friend killed their classmate. But she believes they did. She has never been able to forgive herself.

Word Curses:

Some people call these self-fulfilling prophecies. Those who are familiar with spirit activity call them word curses. They're curses we put on ourselves and others through what we say. If we say things often enough – things such as “I'm never going to be free of my allergies,” or “None of the allergy medicines work for me,” demonic spirits will be more than willing to make those “word curses” come true.
